


HOW U.S. TAXES WERE SPENT DURING WORLD WAR I

U.S. FEDERAL EXPENDITURES 1919 FISCAL YEAR

TOTAL OUTLAYS: \$26 BILLION



\$7 BILLION

- Indians \$35 million
- Postal \$1 million
- Civil & Misc. \$6,628 million (may include some military)

\$9 BILLION


- Veterans \$222 million
- Interest on debt \$619 million
- Debt retirement (mostly Civil War) \$8,015 million

\$11 BILLION

- War Dept. \$9,002 million
- Navy Dept. \$2,002 million

TOTAL MILITARY: 75% AND \$20 BILLION
