A s much as 45% of our federal taxes cover past and present military expenditures. Decent, peace-loving people are paying for weapons that have obliterated most of Gaza and killed between 33,000 and 42,000 people, 13,500 of them children. While Americans struggle to keep up with inflation in food, housing, healthcare, and education costs, \$1.1 trillion dollars is being spent to build new nuclear weapons, weapons the Union of Concerned Scientists say are likely to destroy all life on this planet. None of us voted for our tax dollars to be wasted in such diabolically destructive fashion.
